

Press PLAYto enter the Analog Audio setup page. The page hereunder will be shown:



Set sound mix output mode:

- press the ► RIGHT arrow to enterthe sub-menu. If you want analog stereo signals, set the sound mode to "STEREO".press the ▼ DOWN arrow once to move the selection to "STEREO", than press PLAY.
- If you wantto have Dolby Pro Logic stereo (the decoded signal will create a 2ch reality simulating effect via the R/L connectors), select "LT/RT", then press PLAY.

You can select one of these modes to adjust the Bassand Treblesignal to your best liking. ON will switch the selected mode on and OFF will switch it back to normal Audio playback. Note: Please be advised that sometimes the BASS on an Audio CD or DVD is already very low, using the Bass Boost or Super Bass can overload your speakers resulting in poor sound quality.



FOUALIZER Select this menuitem to set up vourpreferred Equalizer mode. Press PLAY to enter this selection.



Gamma refers to the exponent between video or pixel values and the displayed brightness. You can set the Gamma to these choices andyour liking.

Luma Delay You can adjust the luminance delay by selecting one of these choices to best suit the brightness of yourTV.

When playing a DVD disc and you have selected ON, then the screen will show the angle mark. This will give you the possibility to view multi angle DVD's. (whether this functions works, depends on the disctype in use.) When you have selected OFF, no angle mark will be shown on the screen.

Toselect the language for your On Screen Display (OSD) use this menu item. There are multiple languages available.





ON: To display captions. (Subtitles)
OFF: Captions will not be displayed.
(No Subtitles)



When there is no activity with the Player for some time, a screen saver will start to prevent damage to the screen. SelectON to activate the screen saver function or select **OFF** to deactivate this function

ON: Each time when you turn off the player, it will memorize the last play time. So if you turn on the player the next time and the same disc is played, it will resume play from the last memory point.

OFF: Disable the last memory function



4:3LB Allow you to see movies in their original aspect ratio. The entire frame of the movie will be displayed. 16:9 recorded movies will occupy a smaller portion of the screen and you will see black margins above and below the picture.



4:3PS The movie will be shown full screen without any black margins, but parts of the image will be cut off from the right and left side.



16:9 Allow you to see movies in their original aspect ratio, when connected to a wide screen TV . The entire frame of the movie will be displayed.



16:9 Note: depending the DVD screen format (e.g. 2.35:1), the wide screen setting may still have black margins above and below the picture.











You can set the Hue (for NTSC) to your liking. Press PLAY/SAVE or the ▶ RIGHT arrow to enterthe Hue control, then press the ▲ UP or ▼ DOWN arrow to adjust the image. Press the ▶ LEFT arrow to go image. Press



Select this menu item to setup your preferred video output format. PAL is commonly used in Europe and NTSC is commonly used in the USAand Japan. Select MULTI only if yourTV supports both formats, the output signal will follow automatically the video format on the DVD disc.



You can set the Saturation to your liking.

Press PLAY/SAVE or the ► RIGHT arrow to enter the Saturation control, then press the ▲ UP or ▼ DOWN arrow to adjust the image. Press the ► LEFT arrow to go back to the menu.



For VCD andSVCD, this selection turns **ON or OFF** the Playback Control (PSC) function. VCD orSVCD media have PSC menu's that contains the track list. The default PSC state is set toON. In **OFF** mode, no tracks can be selected.



#### Set age control grade:

For DVD discs with a rating system progr -ammed (for example: the North American CARA) parents can prohibit watching con -tent that mightbe inadvisable for children. Press the RIGHT arrow to enter the submenu. If you want to change the age control grade press either the ▲ UP or ▼ DOWN arrow to scroll to the available sel -ections. Selection 1 is Kid safe, selection 2 is some guidance advisable, selection 3 is PG (Parental guidance suggested, some material may not be suitable for children), selection 4 is PG13 (Parents strongly cau -tioned, some material may be inappropri -iate for children under 13), selection 5 is PG-R (Restricted, under 17 requires acco -mpanying parent or adult guardian), sele -ction 6 is Restricted viewing. selection 7 is NC-17 (No one 17 and under admitted), selection 8 is for Adult Entertainment or X rated movies and NO PARENTAL is for General Audiences (All Ages).

Hereafter a screen will indicate to enter a password, if the ex-factory password has never been modified, you can use [123456] by pressing the according number buttons on the remote control. Select "YES" or "NO" with either the left or the right arrow key and press PLAY to confirm.





When you press SETUP on the panel or on the remote control, the screen will display setup menu.



On the RemoteControl, press eitherthe ▲ UP or ▼ DOWN or ◀ LEFT or ▶ RIGHT arrow buttons to move to the desired menu item and press PLAYto select the menu item



Set TV Display mode to the correct ratio:

- Press the ►RIGHT arrow button to enter the sub-menu. If you wantto set the screen
  to "WIDE", press the ▼ DOWN arrow twice to move your selection until the "WIDE"
  item is selected, now press PLAY.
- Press SETUP to exit these system settings

When you press LANGUAGE on the panel, the screen will display the different types of OSD languages, you can then select the desired OSD language.

When you press DVD on the panel, the screen will display as below and you can adjust the parameters.

Attention: (in DVD state, this item function use to A 1280, A 1281 no use) When you press P1/3 on the panel, the screen will display as below



When you press P2/3 on the panel,(NOTE:When you press MUTE, speaker and IR headphone will be muted.When you press POWER on the panel shortly,the speaker will be muted only,and when you press POWER on the panel for two seconds,it will power off)



When you press P3/3 on the panel, the screen will display as below:



Enter the PIN numbers with the number buttons of the remote control and press PLAY, enter the new password and press PLAY again, confirm your new password and press PLAY again.



## MP3/MPEG4 PLAYBACK

The Multimedia Player is able to play discs (CD-R / CD-RW) recorded with MP3 / MPEG4 audio and video files. When a disc with MP3 or MPEG4 files (including multiple directories) is loaded in the system the following screen is displayed:



To go to the preferred music or video directory, press the ▲▼ arrows to scroll to your selection and confirm your choice by pressing the PLAY button. To select your preferred song or video title, press the ▲▼ arrows to scroll to your selection and confirm your choice by pressing the PLAY button. Your selected song or video will now be played.
